2026 Rules & Regulations: Artisan Vendors

A completed and signed application, which is required to be considered for admittance to the 2026 Sunflower Fair, indicates that the vendor has read and agrees to abide by these Rules & Regulations. Location & Time: Saturday, Sept. 19, 2026: 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Artisan Vendors will be assigned booth spaces along Michigan Avenue and side streets within the fair area.

- Vendors are required to be open from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- The fair is held rain or shine. Failure to abide by this requirement may result in ineligibility for future fairs.
- Early tear-down is NOT permitted. The fair closes promptly at 4 p.m.

Set-Up:

- Set-up occurs between 6:30-8:30 a.m. on Saturday, Sept. 19.
- Vehicles must be moved out of the fair area by 8:30 a.m.
- Finalized booth assignment and set-up instructions will be emailed by Sept. 8, 2026
Please Note: There may be last-minute changes to the layout after the booth assignments have been communicated. A final map and vendor list will be sent on Friday, Sept. 18 at noon.
- Vendor vehicles may be parked on any legal street outside of the fair area or in the parking lots of the Little Learners School at Harrison and Clay streets. Hapdicap parking is available on Harrison Street between Michigan Ave. and Monroe St., but is NOT guaranteed.

Rules & Regulations:

- No power is available for artisan vendors.
- There is no guarantee of exclusivity of your product line.
- You are expected to be present and provide your product the entire time of the fair.
- Dumpsters and trash boxes will be available. Vendors are responsible for the cleanup of assigned booth area and disposal of trash. Failure to do so may result in ineligibility of future fairs.
- All exhibitors are responsible for collection of their own sales tax.
- Exhibitors are responsible for their own booth set-up including tables, chairs and display items. All items must fit entirely inside the designated 10' x 10' space.
- Lessee will maintain and show proof of liability insurance in a minimum amount of \$1,000,000 aggregate \$500,000 per occurrence and the La Porte Economic Advancement Partnership further held harmless and named as an additional insured for any act or occurrence resulting from the vendor, its employees, agents or assigns. A copy of the policy shall be provided to the Event Coordinators.
- Application fee is not refundable.
